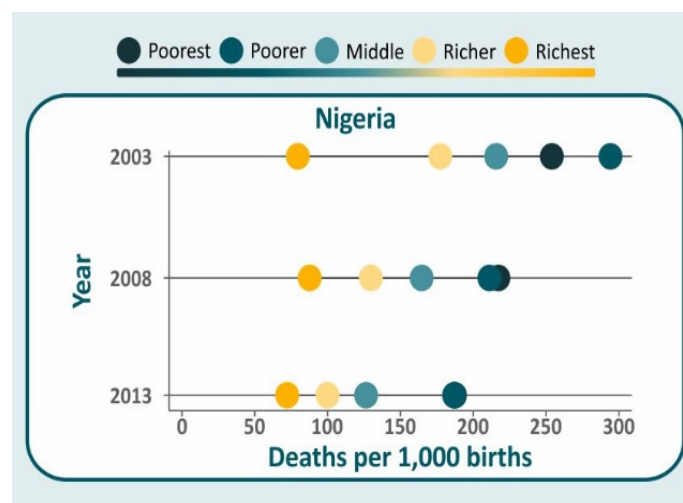
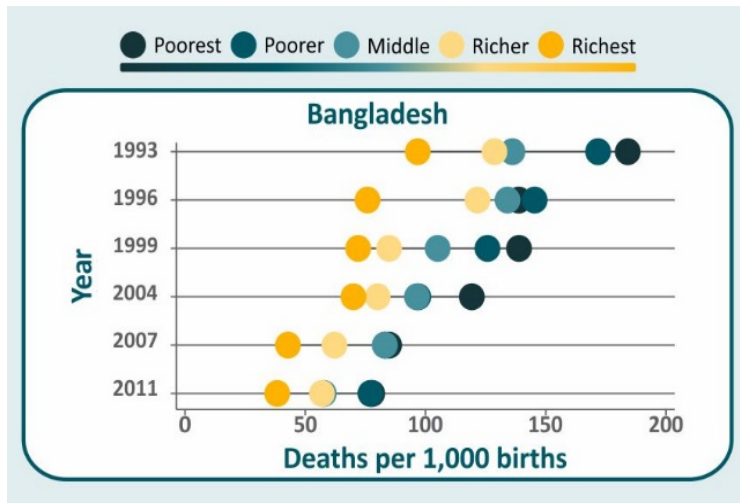
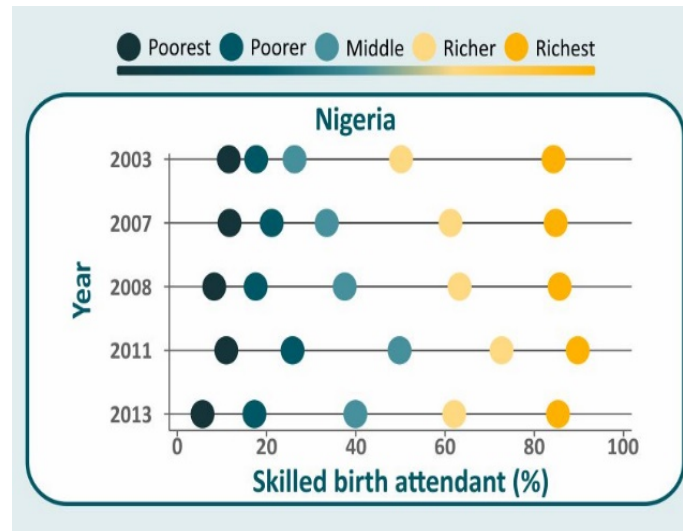
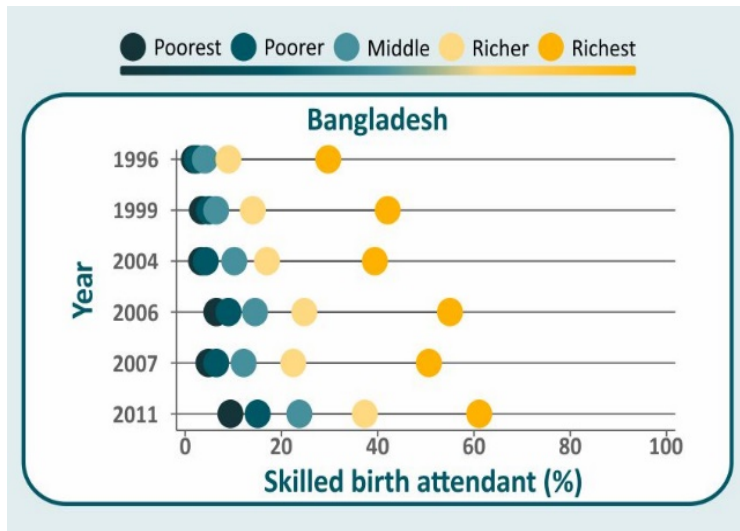
Some interventions are more equitable than others



Some countries are making large improvements



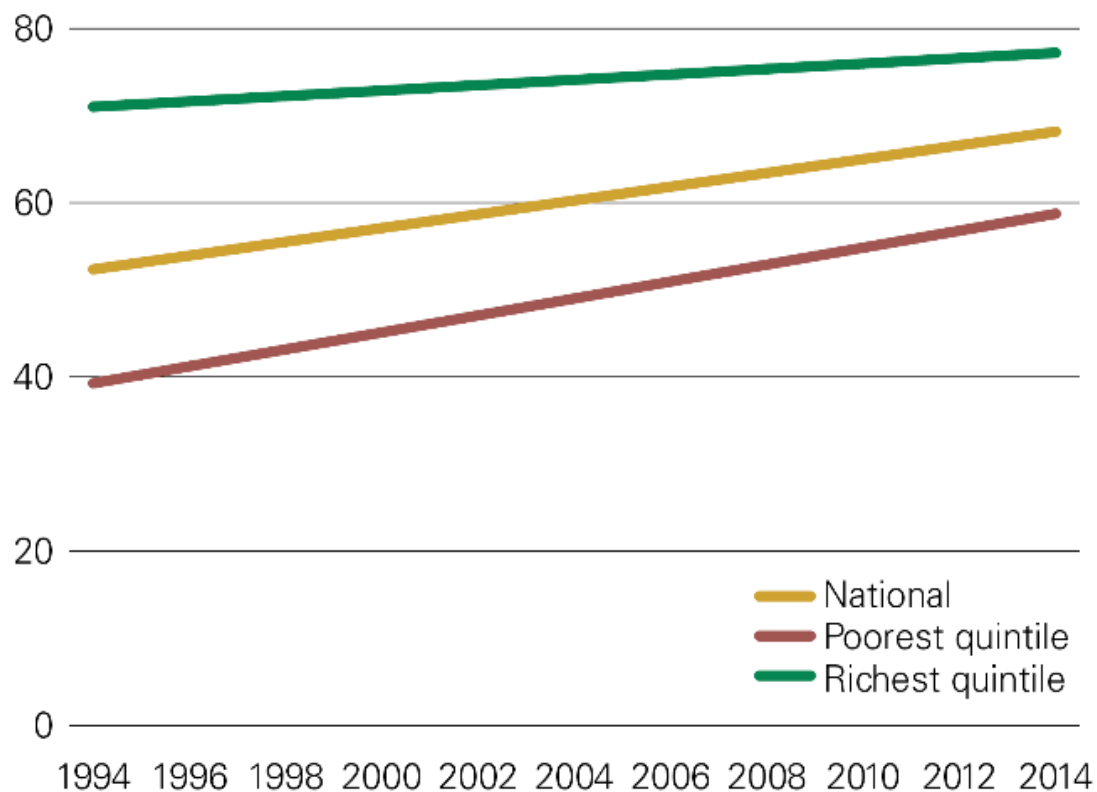
Other countries are not doing so well...
