

Steps Americans Have Taken in Response to the H1N1 Outbreak

% saying in response to reports of H1N1, they/member of their household has...

Washed hands/used hand sanitizer more frequently  **67%**

Made preparations to stay at home if they or family member is sick  **55%**

Avoided air travel  **27%**

Avoided places where many people are gathered together, like sporting events/malls/public transportation  **25%**

% saying in response to reports of H1N1, they personally have...

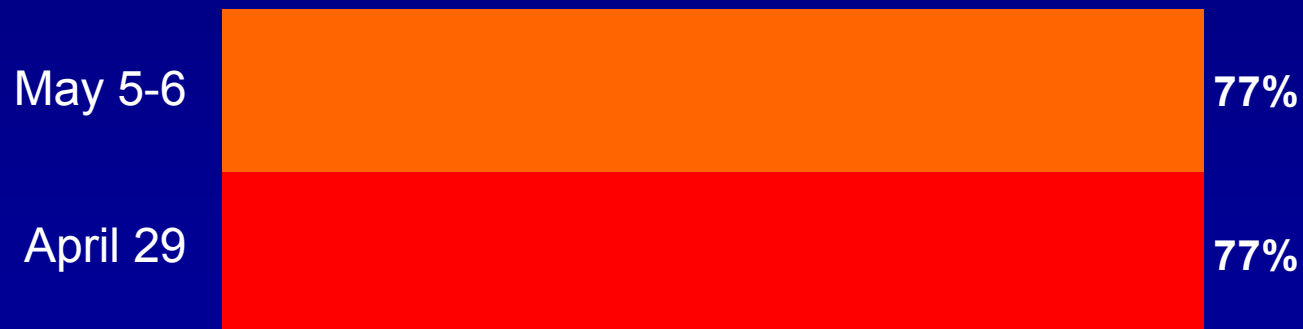
Taken any steps to avoid being near someone who has flu-like symptoms  **35%**
