H1N1 School Closures – Parents of Children in Daycare/School TOPLINE REPORT

The study was conducted for the Harvard School of Public Health via telephone by SSRS/ICR, an independent research company. Interviews were conducted from November 19 – December 9, 2009 among a nationally representative sample of 2354 parents of children under the age of 18 enrolled in school or daycare. Of those, a total of 1110 interviews were conducted with National respondents and a total of 1244 interviews were conducted with respondents that live in high closure areas. Of the respondents that live in high closure areas, 523 experienced school closures (“HC Closed”) and 721 did not experience school closures (“HC Not Closed”). The margin of error for total respondents is +/-xxx% at the 95% confidence level.
