H1N1 Traveler Poll TOPLINE

The study was conducted for the Harvard School of Public Health via telephone by SSRS/ICR, an independent research company. Interviews were conducted from November 12 to November 18, 2009 among a nationally representative sample of 1124 respondents age 18 and older, who have traveled by airplane, bus, train, or cruise ship in the past 12 months.

The margin of error for total respondents is +/-3.63% at the 95% confidence level.
