Participant Registration Instruction Guide

1. Overview

The HSIL Global Health Systems Hackathon brings together students, innovators, clinicians, researchers, technologists, and entrepreneurs across five continents to design high-value health system solutions. Registration is open to all individuals and teams interested in innovation, public health, technology, and health systems strengthening.

This guide outlines the steps and requirements for a successful registration.

2. Eligibility

Participants may register as:

- Individuals (who will be placed into teams)
- Pre-formed Teams (2-6 members recommended)
- Students, professionals, and innovators from any discipline
- Participants from any of the global collaborating hubs (visit our hackathon landing page for more information).

No prior hackathon experience is required.

3. Registration Requirements

To complete registration, participants must:

- 1. Provide basic personal information (name, email, affiliation, hub location).
- 2. Indicate whether they are registering individually or as a team.
- 3. Submit a summary of their idea or problem statement (150–200 words).
 - o This should describe:
 - The health systems problem and why it matters
 - A potential solution or concept
- 4. Agree to HSIL Hackathon **Terms & Conditions**, including IP guidelines.



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4. How to Register

Step 1: Access the Registration Portal ()

Visit the official HSIL Hackathon registration link provided by your local hub or via the HSIL website (https://hsph.harvard.edu/research/health-systems-innovation-lab/work/hsil-hackathon-2026-building-high-value-health-systems-leveraging-ai/)

Step 2: Select Your Registration Category

Choose one of the following:

- Register as an individual
- Register as a team (All team members are required to register separately under your preferred team name)

Step 3: Complete the Online Form

Fill out:

- Contact details
- Academic/professional background
- Preferred in-person participating Hub (e.g. Boston, Toronto, Accra, etc.)
- Your idea summary or problem statement

Step 4: Upload Additional Information

- CV/resume
- LinkedIn Profile
- Personal Website/GitHub

Step 5: Submit Your Registration

Applications will be accepted only after all required fields have been completed and the form has been submitted. Upon submission, you will immediately see a confirmation message on the screen, followed by an email confirmation from HSIL or your respective hub.
