BIOGRAPHY

Shruthi Mahalingaiah, MD, MS, FACOG is the Mark and Catherine Winkler associate professor of environmental, reproductive, and women's health in the Department of Environmental Health at the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health (HSPH). At Mass General Hospital Fertility Center, she serves clinically as a physician specializing in ovulation disorders, reproductive endocrinology and infertility and also serves as Director of Clinical Research in the Division of Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility. As founder of the Mahalingaiah Lab at HSPH, Dr. Mahalingaiah answers research questions about how environmental exposures (such as air pollution, environmental toxicants, and common chemicals) are associated with reproductive health outcomes across the entire lifespan. Her work harnesses the power of digital health platforms and large electronic health record/cohort data to ultimately close the gap in research and clinical care. She has published extensively about ovulation disorders, changes to menstrual cycles and health over time, and fertility outcomes, among other topics. Recent professional accolades include Boston Top Doctor status (2020-2026), receiving the inaugural Carole Mendelson Award from the Society of Reproductive Investigation (2024), serving as an oral board examiner for the subspecialty REI board exam, having served as president of the New England Fertility Society (2019-2021), and receiving the Ellison Family Foundation Award (2017) and the Endocrine Society Early Investigator Award (2016). She attended Harvard Medical School and an OB/GYN residency and fellowship in reproductive endocrinology and infertility at Mass General Brigham. She received a Master of Science in epidemiology at Boston University School of Public Health in 2015. Dr. Mahalingaiah additionally received a BA from Middlebury College, where she dual majored in chemistry/Spanish and dual minored in physics/dance.

Shruthi Mahalingaiah, MD, MS, FACOG is the Mark and Catherine Winkler associate professor of environmental, reproductive, and women's health at the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health.
